- Demonstrating flexibility and agility in responding to Myanmar's dynamic and evolving context.
- Ensuring transparency through clear communication with clarity on roles and responsibilities, and through accountability to our partners and to the people and communities with and for whom we work.
- Promoting women's equal representation at all levels.
- Recognising the added value of both innovation in the Myanmar context and lessons from peacebuilding practice in other contexts.
